



Pope Francis Reflects on the Ascension



"In the Creed we say that Jesus 'ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.' His earthly life culminated with the Ascension, when he passed from this world to the Father to sit on his right. What does this mean and how does it affect our life?

"During the Ascension Jesus made the priestly gesture of blessing and his apostles knelt with bowed heads. They acknowledged that Jesus is the one eternal High Priest who passed through death and ascended into heaven. He is now with God the Father where he intercedes for ever in our favor. He is now our Advocate, the One who always defends us from the snares of the devil, who defends us from ourselves and from our sins!

"As the apostles, he offers us a blessing. The Ascension of Jesus into heaven reminds us of this deeply consoling reality: in Christ, true God and true man, our humanity was taken to God. Christ opened the path for us. He is like a roped guide climbing a mountain who, on reaching the summit, pulls us up to him and leads us to God. If we let ourselves be guided by him, we are in the safe hands of our Saviour and our Advocate.

"After having seen Jesus ascending into heaven, Apostles returned to Jerusalem "with great joy." This may seem a little odd to us. When are separated from our relatives or friends by a definitive departure there is usually a natural sadness. But with the gaze of faith the Apostles saw that although Jesus had been removed from

their sight, he remained with them and in the glory of the Father and intercedes for them.

"The Ascension does not focus on Jesus' absence, but teaches us that he is alive in our midst in a new way. He is no longer in a specific place in the world as he was before the Ascension. He is now in the lordship of God, present in every space and time, close to each one of us. We are never alone: we have this Advocate who defends us, the Crucified and Risen Lord who guides us.

"We also have with us a multitude of brothers and sisters who in their family life and at work, in their problems and hardships, in their joys and hopes, live faith daily. Together we can bring to the world the love of the Risen Christ who is now ascended into Heaven where he is our Advocate."
